

Intoxicating Hemp


Also referred to as








Chemical "Cousins"

THC-P: High Potency Risk



- •This 5000 mg package has 50 times amount of THC in a **legal cannabis** edible package (100mg)
- THC-P is over thirty times the potency of delta-9 THC





How Did This Happen

The Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018 (2018 Farm Bill)

"The term 'hemp' means the plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a delta-9 THC concentration of not more than 0.3% on a dry weight basis."

Farm Bill 2018

Loopholes

- State and federal agencies do not have capacity to test right now
- · Only considers the growing of hemp, not the altering of hemp
- · Labs unable to determine all chemicals added to products
- Considers serving size but not quantity in packaged intoxicating hemp (i.e., edibles, "dry weight")
- · No age restrictions in place

Big Tobacco's Playbook


- Big Cannabis using aggressive marketing tactics like Big Tobacco
- Packaged edibles usually use bright colors, cartoon-like images, or other features that are attractive to youth
- Flavored products to attract younger consumers (e.g., bubble gum, cake)

Youth & Intoxicating Hemp



Easy Access

- Over half of CA 10th graders using cannabis are starting with intoxicating hemp products
- Widely available online and in retailers (smoke shops, liquor stores, gas stations)
- Packaging may not be child-resistant



Youth & Intoxicating Hemp

Health Risks

- · Find it harder to remember, multitask, and pay attention
- · Poorer outcomes in school and social life
- Increased risk of psychosis, suicidal ideation, depression, anxiety
- Other studies found that users experienced
 - Impaired brain development, irreversible harm to developing brain
 - Lung damage (infections, coughing, lung scarring)
 - Memory problems
 - · Heart disease


Youth Cannabis Use Rates






	Santa Clara County Youth	California Youth
High school students who have tried cannabis	27.4%	21.4%
High school students who used in the last 30 days	13.4%	8.8%
12 th grade students	17.6%	8.8%
10 th grade students	9.4%	6.5%
Cannabis use	13.4%	8.8%
Tobacco use	8.8%	6.5%

Lack of Lab Testing





 Δ^8 -Tetrahydrocannabinol

- •"A lot of irresponsible production is going on."
 - UC San Diego, Center for Medicinal Cannabis Research
- No one testing the strength of the acids and residual metals
- "A soup" of byproducts and unwanted compounds

Proverde Laboratories

- •Unable to determine a true delta-8-THC product due to all the alterations.
- •Small sample had 10 compounds that are unidentifiable











Intoxicating Hemp Undermines Regulated Cannabis Market

- Recall processes, accountability, and enforcement unavailable
- 0.3% Delta-9 THC in dry weight can result in a much higher proportion of THC in concentrated form
 - Edibles and beverages with up to 100 times the THC allowed in the regulated California cannabis market

What Can We Do About It

Total Ban

Do not allow products on either markets.

For example: Prohibit
the sale of
intoxicating hemp
with <1mg of
chemically altered
THC per package &
0.5 mg per dose

Regulate

Establish regulation within the hemp regulatory framework

Transition

Outlaw in hemp market but include in the cannabis market


